# Volkswagen Group Diesel Efficiency Stichting Report of the Supervisory Board 2019-2021 (year-to-date) Last updated: 3 March 2021

## INTRODUCTION

### Task of Supervisory Board

The supervisory board ("**Supervisory Board**") of Volkswagen Group Diesel Efficiency Stichting (the "**Foundation**") is responsible for supervision of: i) the policies of the board of directors of the Foundation (the "**Board**"); and ii) the general course of affairs in the Foundation.

#### Composition of the Supervisory Board

In the period covered by this report, the Supervisory Board consisted of the following members:

- Mr. Jaap Koelewijn until 1 October 2020
- Mr. Henk Vreeman as of 1 September 2020

Pursuant to Principle VII of the Dutch Claim Code 2019, the Supervisory Board shall consist of at least three members. There are currently two vacancies. The Supervisory Board seeks to fill the two vacancies in the first half of 2021.
