Subject cooperation agreement

Dear Members of the Board,

With reference to the multiple discussions over the last years between Consumentenbond, Volkswagen Group Diesel Efficiency Stichting (the “**Foundation**”) and its advisors, I am sending you this letter.

On 25 September 2020 Consumentenbond and the Foundation entered into an exclusive cooperation agreement for the purpose of launching a campaign to obtain appropriate relief from Volkswagen AG, and/or Volkswagen Group Entities, legal entities related to the production of Volkswagen Group Vehicles, and/or manufacturers and/or lessors of Volkswagen Group Vehicles (together: “**Volkswagen**”) for all current and former Volkswagen car owners and lease drivers who suffered loss or damages as a result of the Diesel Emissions Scandal, committed by Volkswagen.

Consumentenbond fully supports and endorses the Foundation in seeking appropriate redress – in or out of court – vis-à-vis Volkswagen for Netherlands-based current and former owners or lessees of (a) Volkswagen Group Vehicle(s) that suffered harm or damages when they purchased, leased or used vehicles containing emissions cheating software. In particular, Consumentenbond supports and endorses the ongoing litigation that the Foundation is pursuing for the benefit of individual consumers against Volkswagen AG in order to obtain ‘bellwether judgments’.

The Foundation is authorized to refer to this letter in court and may submit this letter as an exhibit. Parties may publish this letter on their website.
